Implant surgery aftercare and precautions

Aftercare and regular visits to the clinic are most important keys to

Implant surgery aftercare



Minor bleeding may occur after the surgery. Please bite down on the gauze and you may swallow any saliva and/or bleeding.



Anesthetic may last up to 3-4 hours after the surgery.

Please do not eat anything until the anesthetic had worn off.



Some swelling may occur after the surgery. Please apply the icepack for 1-3 days.



Diet consisting of softer and colder food is recommended during 48 hours following surgery. Please avoid any hot and spicy food and also any alcohol or smoking.



Plenty of rest on the day of the surgery is recommended. Exercise or sauna should be avoided for one week following surgery.



Please do not use the toothbrush on the surgery area for 7 days. Please rinse your mouth 2 times a day (morning and night) using recommended gral disinfectant



Please take all of prescribed medicine and avoid taking any aspirin. If any of below occurs following surgery, please contact the clinic.

- Anesthetic lasting more than 10 hours
- Excessive bleeding
- Implant screw coming loose or shaking

Regular visits to clinic

	Duration	Examination
1st implant surgery	1 week after	Clean and disinfect surgery area and remove any stitches (suture)
	2-6 months after	Secondary surgery : connect abutment(post) and temporary crown
2nd implant surgery	1 month after	Final crown
	1-2 times every 6 months	Check the stability of the implant and oral cavity hygiene
	Once a year
